## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth
- 2 of Pennsylvania providing for certain legislative actions
- 3 when a budget is not adopted before the end of a fiscal year.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- hereby resolves as follows: 5
- 6 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
- the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with
- 8 the provisions of Article XI thereof:
- 9 That section 13 of Article VIII be amended by adding a
- 10 subsection to read:
- 11 § 13. Appropriations.

- 13 (c) If the General Assembly has not adopted a budget, (i)
- within 30 days prior to the end of a fiscal year, then the 14
- 15 legislative activities of the General Assembly shall be
- 16 restricted solely to matters concerning taxation and the budget,
- (ii) within 15 days prior to the end of a fiscal year, then the 17
- General Assembly shall remain in continuous session until the 18

- budgetary problems are solved. Stopgap legislation of a 1
- 2 <u>budgetary nature shall not remove the effect of this limitation.</u>
- 3 The limitation shall not apply to emergency legislation
- 4 necessary to cope with situations deemed an emergency by the
- 5 Governor.
