6	Section 1. County Medical Examiner created.
7	(a) There is hereby created in every county of the
8	Commonwealth an Office of County Medical Examiner.
9	(b) The District Attorney shall appoint a person who is
10	either a Doctor of Medicine or a Doctor of Osteopathy to be the
11	County Medical Examiner.
12	(c) The term of the County Medical Examiner shall be four
13	years.

2 Section 2. Power and duties of County Medical Examiner.

3 The County Medical Examiner shall have the same power and 4 duties as currently vested in the Office of Coroner by law. 5 Section 3. Creation of State board.

6 (a) There is hereby created a State Board of Medical
7 Examiners hereinafter referred to as the "board." It shall
8 consist of the Secretary of Health and two persons appointed by
9 the Governor who shall possess experience in pathology.

10 (b) The board may overrule the County Medical Examiner and 11 the District Attorney regarding the death of any person upon the 12 appeal by:

13 (1) Any person related by blood or marriage to the14 deceased.

15 (2) Any person accused in any criminal proceeding16 involving the death.

17 (3) Any municipal, county, or State law enforcement18 official.

19 Section 4. Effective date.

20 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
