AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 2 consolidated Statutes, further providing for rape.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Section 3121 of Title 18, act of November 25,
- 6 1970 (P.L.707, No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 3121. Rape.
- 9 <u>(a) General rule.--</u>A person commits a felony of the first
- 10 degree when he engages in sexual intercourse with another person
- 11 not his spouse:
- 12 (1) by forcible compulsion;
- 13 (2) by threat of forcible compulsion that would prevent
- 14 resistance by a person of reasonable resolution;
- 15 (3) who is unconscious; or
- 16 (4) who is so mentally deranged or deficient that such
- person is incapable of consent.
- 18 (b) Special sentencing provisions. -- A person who inflicts

- 1 serious bodily injury during the commission of a rape for which
- 2 he is found quilty pursuant to subsection (a) shall be
- 3 <u>imprisoned under total confinement for a term which shall be</u>
- 4 fixed by the court at not less than ten years. No person
- 5 <u>sentenced pursuant to this subsection shall be eliqible for</u>
- 6 parole or release during said term of minimum mandatory
- 7 confinement as herein provided unless the conviction of said
- 8 person is set aside or unless said person receives a pardon
- 9 pursuant to Article IV, section 9 of the Constitution of the
- 10 <u>Commonwealth of Pennsylvania</u>. <u>Nothing in this subsection shall</u>
- 11 <u>be construed to prohibit the imposition of a more severe</u>
- 12 <u>sentence than the term of minimum mandatory confinement</u>
- 13 prescribed herein provided such sentence does not exceed the
- 14 maximum sentence that may be imposed for the commission of a
- 15 felony of the first degree.
- 16 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
