AN ACT

- 1 Relating to the liability of the owner of a dog to respond in damages for acts of his dog in certain cases.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. (a) The owner of any dog which shall bite a
- 6 person while such person is on or in a public place, or lawfully
- 7 on or in a private place, including the property of the owner of
- 8 the dog, shall be liable for all such damages to the person or
- 9 property resulting from the dog's attack as may be suffered by
- 10 the person bitten, regardless of the former viciousness of such
- 11 dog or the owner's knowledge of such viciousness.
- 12 (b) For the purpose of this act a person is lawfully upon
- 13 the private property of such owner when he is on the property in
- 14 the performace of any duty imposed upon him by the laws of this
- 15 State or the laws or postal regulations of the United States, or
- 16 when he is on such property upon the invitation, express or
- 17 implied, of the owner thereof.
- 18 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
