AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 23, 1931 (P.L.932, No.317), entitled
2 "An act relating to cities of the third class; and amending,
3 revising, and consolidating the law relating thereto,"
4 further providing for cost of living increases for certain
5 persons.

6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
7 hereby enacts as follows:

8 Section 1. Section 4322.1, act of June 23, 1931 (P.L.932,
9 No.317), known as "The Third Class City Code," reenacted and
10 amended June 28, 1951 (P.L.662, No.164), and amended June 30,
11 1969 (P.L.98, No.36), is amended to read:

12 Section 4322.1. Increase of Allowances After Retirement.--
13 Any city may, at any time, at its discretion, upon the
14 recommendation of the persons having custody and management of
15 the firemen's pension fund, increase the allowances of persons
16 receiving allowances of any kind from the fund by reason of and
17 after the termination of the services of any member of the fund.
18 Such increases shall be in conformity with a uniform percentage
19 scale, which may be based on the cost of living[, but the total
20 of any such allowances shall not at any time exceed one-half of

- 1 the current salary being paid firemen of the highest pay grade].
- 2 Such increases shall be paid from the general fund of the city.
- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
