- 1 Amending Title 24 (Education) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, further providing for cost-of-living adjustments of
- 3 supplemental annuities.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 8349 (a) and (b) of Title 24, act of
- 7 November 25, 1970 (P.L.707, No.230), known as the Pennsylvania
- 8 Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:
- 9 § 8348. Supplemental annuities.
- 10 (a) General rule. -- Every annuitant who is in receipt of a
- 11 superannuation, withdrawal or disability annuity, shall continue
- 12 to receive such annuity and beginning July 1, [1974,] 1978, any
- 13 annuitant who retired on or prior to July 1, [1973,] 1976, shall
- 14 receive a cost-of-living supplement determined as a percentage
- 15 applied to the entire retirement annuity as of June 30, [1974.
- 16 Beginning July 1, 1974, any annuitant whose effective date of
- 17 retirement is after July 1, 1973 and prior to March 1, 1974
- 18 shall receive a supplement determined as an adjustment of 5%

- 1 applied to the entire retirement annuity on the effective date
- 2 of retirement. All supplements provided in this subsection]
- 3 <u>1978</u>. Such cost-of-living supplement shall be payable under the
- 4 same terms and conditions as provided under the option plan in
- 5 effect as of June 30, [1974.] and shall be of the year of
- 6 <u>adjustment a constant proportion of percentage increases in the</u>
- 7 Consumer Price Index for all Urban Consumers, Bureau of Labor
- 8 Statistics, United States Department of Labor (CPIU) prepared
- 9 and published by the United States Department of Labor
- 10 Statistics. For increases payable July 1, 1978 each percentage
- 11 <u>factor shall be equal to two-thirds of the percentage change in</u>
- 12 <u>said index from June 1973 or June of the fiscal year of</u>
- 13 retirement, whichever is later, to June 1977. In 1979 and each
- 14 year thereafter between January 1, and February, the retirement
- 15 board shall determine the percentage change in the Consumer
- 16 Price Index for all Urban Consumers, Bureau of Labor Statistics,
- 17 <u>United States Department of Labor (CPIU) from the later of June</u>
- 18 1977 or June of the year preceding the most recent cost-of-
- 19 living adjustment to June of the year preceding the
- 20 <u>determination</u>. On the basis of the determination and effective
- 21 July 1 thereafter each annuity paid as of this date to a member
- 22 who retired at least two years prior to this date shall be
- 23 adjusted by two-thirds of the percentage change in the Consumer
- 24 Price Index so determined.
- 25 [(b) Cost-of-living adjustment factors.--The percentage
- 26 which is to be applied in the determination of the cost-of-
- 27 living supplements shall be determined on the basis of the
- 28 effective date of retirement as follows:
- 29 Effective date of retirement Percentage factor
- 30 After July 1, 1971 through July 1, 1973

1	After July 1, 1970 through July 1, 1971	10%
2	After July 1, 1969 through July 1, 1970	15%
3	After July 1, 1968 through July 1, 1969	20%
4	After July 1, 1967 through July 1, 1968	25%
5	On or prior to July 1, 1967	30%]

7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
