## AN ACT

Amending the act of April 14, 1949 (P.L.482, No.98), entitled, 2 as amended, "An act authorizing and requiring cities, 3 boroughs, townships, municipal authorities and public utility companies engaged in the supplying of water, to shut off the 5 supply of water for nonpayment of sewer, sewerage, or sewage treatment rentals, rates, or charges imposed by municipal 7 authorities organized by counties of the second class, by 8 cities of the second class, by cities of the second class A, 9 by cities of the third class, by boroughs or by townships of the first or second class; authorizing and requiring them to 10 supply to such authorities lists of metered water readings 11 and flat-rate water bills and other data; authorizing them to 12 13 act as billing and collecting agents for such authorities; 14 and conferring certain powers upon the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission in connection therewith, " restricting the 15 shutting off of water under certain circumstances. 16 17 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 18 19 Section 1. The act of April 14, 1949 (P.L.482, No.98), 20 entitled, as amended, "An act authorizing and requiring cities, 21 boroughs, townships, municipal authorities and public utility 22 companies engaged in the supplying of water, to shut off the 23 supply of water for nonpayment of sewer, sewerage, or sewage treatment rentals, rates, or charges imposed by municipal 24

- 7 powers upon the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission in
- 8 connection therewith, " is amended by adding a section to read:
- 9 <u>Section 1.1. Notwithstanding any provision of this act to</u>
- 10 the contrary, no water utility shall shut off water supply to
- 11 any person for nonpayment of sewer bills if said person's
- 12 property is not connected to an enclosed sewer line approved by
- 13 the Department of Environmental Resources.
- 14 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
