- 3 public schools.
- 4 A considerable segment of public opinion is opposed to the
- 5 results of this decision; therefore be it
- 6 RESOLVED (the Senate concurring), That the General Assembly
- 7 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania memorialize the Congress of
- 8 the United States to propose an amendment to the Constitution of
- 9 the United States to permit the various states to provide for
- 10 the voluntary reciting of the Lord's Prayer and the reading of
- 11 verses of the Bible in public schools; and be it further
- 12 RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to
- 13 the presiding officers of each House of the Congress of the
- 14 United States and to each Senator and Representative from
- 15 Pennsylvania in the Congress of the United States.
