- 5 WHEREAS, SNAP is committed to improvement of the quality of
- 6 care that the nursing student provides, and improvement of
- 7 public awareness to pertinent medical issues; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Each year money is spent on cancer research with the
- 9 hope of prolonging the life of the cancer victim with the plan
- 10 of returning him/her to a productive life; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Hundreds of thousands of cancer victims are
- 12 unemployed because of their medical records and discrimination
- 13 against cured cancer patients; therefore be it
- 14 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives joins with SNAP
- 15 in strongly condemning the employment discrimination of persons
- 16 with or cured of cancer; and be it further
