REFERRED TO COMMITTEE ON RULES, MARCH 30, 1977

In the House of Representatives, March 29, 1977

1 WHEREAS, The Student Nurses Association of Pennsylvania
2 (SNAP), a constituent of the National Student Nurses
3 Association, is the representative of the undergraduate nursing
4 student in Pennsylvania; and

5 WHEREAS, SNAP is committed to improvement of the quality of
6 care that the nursing student provides, and improvement of
7 public awareness to pertinent medical issues; and

8 WHEREAS, Each year money is spent on cancer research with the
9 hope of prolonging the life of the cancer victim with the plan
10 of returning him/her to a productive life; and

11 WHEREAS, Hundreds of thousands of cancer victims are
12 unemployed because of their medical records and discrimination
13 against cured cancer patients; therefore be it

14 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives joins with SNAP
15 in strongly condemning the employment discrimination of persons
16 with or cured of cancer; and be it further

17 RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be sent to the
18 American Nurses' Association, Pennsylvania Nurses Association,

1 American Cancer Society, American Medical Association, National
2 League for Nursing, Pennsylvania League for Nursing, National
3 Student Nurses' Association, and other related organizations
