## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of July 28, 1953 (P.L.723, No.230), entitled,
- as amended, "An act relating to counties of the second class
- and second class A; amending, revising, consolidating and
- 4 changing the laws relating thereto, " requiring mandatory
- 5 audits of the minor judiciary.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. The act of July 28, 1953 (P.L.723, No.230), known
- 9 as the "Second Class County Code," is amended by adding a
- 10 section to read:
- 11 Section 1922.1. Audit of Accounts of Minor Judiciary. -- The
- 12 controller shall annually audit the accounts of every alderman,
- 13 magistrate or justice of the peace within the county and report
- 14 the results of such audits to the county commissioners, the
- 15 Auditor General and to the governing body of each political
- 16 subdivision which is entitled or has a right to receive any
- 17 moneys or funds collected by any such alderman, magistrate or
- 18 justice of the peace.
- 19 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
