- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, changing reasonable to unreasonable.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Subsection (e) of section 108 of Title 18, act of
- 6 November 25, 1970 (P.L.707, No.230), known as the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes, is amended to read:
- 8 § 108. Time limitations.
- 9 \* \* \*
- 10 (e) Commencement of prosecution. -- A prosecution is commenced
- 11 either when an indictment is found or when an information is
- 12 issued by an attorney for the Commonwealth in those counties
- 13 where he is authorized to do so or when a warrant or summons is
- 14 issued, if such warrant or summons is executed without
- 15 [reasonable] <u>unreasonable</u> delay.

- 17 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
