1 IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS RELATING TO PRIMARY ELECTIONS 2 OF THE ACT OF JUNE 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, NO.320), KNOWN AS THE 3 "PENNSYLVANIA ELECTION CODE," THE NOMINEES SHALL BE DETERMINED 4 IN THE SAME MANNER AS IS NOW PROVIDED FOR BY LAW IN THE CASE OF 5 SUBSTITUTED NOMINEES WHERE A CANDIDATE OF A POLITICAL PARTY HAS DIED SUBSEQUENT TO A PRIMARY ELECTION. EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE 6 7 PROVIDED HEREIN, THE NOMINATION AND ELECTION OF THE JUDGESHIPS 8 TO BE FILLED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION SHALL BE GOVERNED 9 BY THE GENERAL ELECTION LAWS APPLICABLE TO THE NOMINATION AND 10 ELECTION OF JUDGES TO THE COURT OF COMMON PLEAS.
