11	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
12	hereby enacts as follows:
13	Section 1. This supplement shall be known and may be cited
14	as the "Motor License Fund Supplement to the General
15	Appropriation Act of 1977."
16	Section 2. The following sums or as much thereof as may be
17	necessary, are hereby specifically appropriated from the Motor
18	License Fund to the hereinafter named agencies of the
19	Commonwealth for the payment of salaries, wages and other
20	compensation and travel expenses of the duly elected or
21	appointed officers and employees of the Commonwealth, for

contractual services and other expenses necessary for the proper

conduct of the duties, functions and activities for the purposes
hereinafter set forth for the fiscal period beginning July 1,
1977 and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid
at the close of the fiscal period ending June 30, 1977.
