A SUPPLEMENT

1 To the act of (P.L. , No.), entitled "An act to
2 provide for the expenses of the Executive, Legislative and
3 Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth, the public debt,
4 and for the public schools for the fiscal period July 1, 1977
5 to June 30, 1978, and for the payment of bills incurred and
6 remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending
7 June 30, 1977," itemizing appropriations required from the
8 Motor License Fund for the proper operation of the several
9 departments of the Commonwealth authorized to spend Motor
10 License Fund moneys.

11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
12 hereby enacts as follows:

13 Section 1. This supplement shall be known and may be cited
14 as the "Motor License Fund Supplement to the General
15 Appropriation Act of 1977."

16 Section 2. The following sums or as much thereof as may be
17 necessary, are hereby specifically appropriated from the Motor
18 License Fund to the hereinafter named agencies of the
19 Commonwealth for the payment of salaries, wages and other
20 compensation and travel expenses of the duly elected or
21 appointed officers and employees of the Commonwealth, for

6 construction and development including
7 encouragement and development of aeronautics,
8 development of State airports, assistance to
9 political subdivisions and municipal authorities
10 in the construction and improvement of airports
11 and other aeronautical improvement of airports
12 and other aeronautical facilities..... 1,511,000

13 No more shall be expended from this item for
14 such purpose or any of them than may be required
15 to match an equal sum contributed by any political
16 subdivision, or municipality authority of the
17 Commonwealth or by the Federal Government, or by
18 a political subdivision or municipality authority
19 and the Federal Government as provided in the act
20 of May 2, 1947 (P.L.136, No.56), entitled "An act
21 relating to Federal aid to political subdivision
22 or municipality authority for the development of
23 public airports."

11 Section 3. In addition to the amounts appropriated by this

12 act, all moneys received from the Federal Government or from any

13 other source as contributions to or payments for the programs

14 provided herein shall be paid into the Motor License Fund and

15 are hereby appropriated out of the Motor License Fund for the

16 purposes and programs intended.

17 Section 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 1977.
