5	Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 5121 of Title 18, act
6	of November 25, 1970 (P.L.707, No.230), known as the
7	Denneylyania Congolidated Statutes is amended to read:

- 8 § 5121. Escape.
- 9 (a) Escape. -- A person commits an offense if he:
- 10 (1) unlawfully removes himself from official detention;
- 11 [or fails to return to official detention following temporary
- leave granted for a specific purpose or limited period.]
- 13 (2) fails to report to the assigned place of employment,
- 14 training, education or other authorized destination; or
- 15 (3) fails to return to official detention following
- 16 <u>temporary leave granted for a specific purpose or limited</u>
- 17 period.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
