## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of January 25, 1966 (1965 P.L.1542, No.538),
- 2 entitled "An act creating a Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 3 Council on the Arts, for the encouragement and development of
- 4 the various arts, and making an appropriation therefor,"
- further providing for the powers of the council.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Sections 5 and 6, act of January 25, 1966 (1965)
- 9 P.L.1542, No.538), entitled "An act creating a Commonwealth of
- 10 Pennsylvania Council on the Arts, for the encouragement and
- 11 development of the various arts, and making an appropriation
- 12 therefor, " are amended to read:
- 13 Section 5. The council shall:
- 14 (1) Make a comprehensive survey of public and private
- 15 institutions engaged within the State in artistic and cultural
- 16 activities, [including but not limited] relating to music,
- 17 theater, dance, painting, sculpture, architecture and allied
- 18 arts and crafts [and of such other cultural resources in the
- 19 State as are contemplated by this act].
- 20 (2) Determine the legitimate <u>artistic</u> needs [and aspirations

- 1 culturally and artistically] of our citizens in all parts of the
- 2 State.
- 3 (3) Ascertain how these resources, including those already
- 4 in existence and those which should be brought to existence, are
- 5 to serve the [cultural] artistic needs [amd aspirations] of the
- 6 citizens of the State.
- 7 (4) Assist the communities within the State in originating
- 8 and creating their own [cultural and] artistic programs.
- 9 (5) Submit a report to the Governor and to the Legislature
- 10 not later than ten calendar days following the commencement of
- 11 each regular session of the Legislature concerning such studies
- 12 it has made and such actions it has taken and recommending such
- 13 legislation and other action as is necessary for the
- 14 implementation and enforcement of this act. The council shall
- 15 submit a first report to the Governor and the Legislature at the
- 16 1966 regular session.
- 17 Section 6. Nothing contained in this act shall be construed
- 18 as [limiting or] vesting power in the council to encroach upon
- 19 or usurp the power vested in any other commission or agency
- 20 heretofore created under the laws of this Commonwealth; nor
- 21 shall the council allocate any funds to assist any artistic or
- 22 other program unless the governing body of the municipality in
- 23 which the program will be located shall by resolution affirm its
- 24 support of the program and the request for funds. No funds shall
- 25 be allocated by the council to assist any artistic or other
- 26 programs without the affirmative vote of at least ten members of
- 27 the council and each application for assistance shall be
- 28 <u>separately considered</u>.
- 29 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
