AN ACT

1 Amending the act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323, No.130), entitled
2 "An act relating to counties of the third, fourth, fifth,
3 sixth, seventh and eighth classes; amending, revising,
4 consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto,"
5 changing certain provisions relating to expenses for the
6 association of county commissioners.

7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8 hereby enacts as follows:

9 Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 445, act of August 9,
10 1955 (P.L.323, No.130), known as "The County Code," amended July
11 30, 1975 (P.L.153, No.77), is amended to read:

12 Section 445. Annual Assessments for County Commissioners,
13 Etc.--(a) In addition to the expenses hereinbefore authorized,
14 the necessary expenses of the association of county
15 commissioners, county solicitors and chief clerks shall be
16 apportioned among the counties holding membership in the
17 association in amounts provided for by the rules and regulations
18 of the association but shall not total more than:

19 (1) [twelve hundred dollars (\$1,200)] twenty-four hundred
20 dollars (\$2,400) for any county of the third class;

1 (2) [one thousand dollars (\$1,000)] two thousand dollars
2 (\$2,000) for any county of the fourth class;
3 (3) [eight hundred dollars (\$800)] sixteen hundred dollars
4 (\$1,600) for any county of the fifth class;
5 (4) [six hundred dollars (\$600)] twelve hundred dollars
6 (\$1,200) for any county of the sixth class;
7 (5) [four hundred dollars (\$400)] eight hundred dollars
8 (\$800) for any county of the seventh class; or
9 (6) [three hundred dollars (\$300)] six hundred dollars
10 (\$600) for any county of the eighth class per annum.

12 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
