This section shall not prevent 8 any district superintendent, assistant district superintendent, 9 10 supervisor, teacher, or employe of any school district, from 11 being a school director in a district other than the one in which he is so employed, and other than in a district with which 12 13 the district in which he is employed operates a joint school or department. A school director shall not be eligible to the 14 15 office of member of council in any municipality. Notwithstanding 16 anything in this section or any other act to the contrary, no person shall be deemed ineligible for the office of school 17 18 director solely on the basis that such person is a member of the classified service under any applicable civil service law. 19 20 Section 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of any inconsistency. 21 22 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
