AN ACT

Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), entitled "An act relating to the finances of the State government; 3 providing for the settlement, assessment, collection, and lien of taxes, bonus, and all other accounts due the 5 Commonwealth, the collection and recovery of fees and other 6 money or property due or belonging to the Commonwealth, or 7 any agency thereof, including escheated property and the 8 proceeds of its sale, the custody and disbursement or other disposition of funds and securities belonging to or in the 9 10 possession of the Commonwealth, and the settlement of claims against the Commonwealth, the resettlement of accounts and 11 appeals to the courts, refunds of moneys erroneously paid to 12 the Commonwealth, auditing the accounts of the Commonwealth 13 14 and all agencies thereof, of all public officers collecting 15 moneys payable to the Commonwealth, or any agency thereof, and all receipts of appropriations from the Commonwealth and 16 17 imposing penalties; affecting every department, board, 18 commission, and officer of the State government, every 19 political subdivision of the State, and certain officers of 20 such subdivisions, every person, association, and corporation 21 required to pay, assess, or collect taxes, or to make returns 22 or reports under the laws imposing taxes for State purposes, 23 or to pay license fees or other moneys to the Commonwealth, 24 or any agency thereof, every State depository and every 25 debtor or creditor of the Commonwealth," authorizing the department to utilize additional methods of making payments. 26

- 27 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 28 hereby enacts as follows:
- 29 Section 1. Section 1503, act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343,
- 30 No.176), known as "The Fiscal Code," subsection (a) amended June

- 1 6, 1939 (P.L.261, No.145) subsection (b) amended March 18, 1971
- 2 (P.L.109, No.4) and subsection (c) amended November 23, 1976
- 3 (P.L.1121, No.234), is amended to read:
- 4 Section 1503. Payments.--(a) All payments out of the
- 5 several funds in the State Treasury shall be made by any means
- 6 acceptable to the Department of Banking or by check of the
- 7 Treasury Department, to be signed by the State Treasurer, or
- 8 someone by him duly authorized, or bearing a facsimile of the
- 9 State Treasurer's signature. Except as otherwise provided in
- 10 paragraph (b) of this section, the State Treasurer shall
- 11 determine the form and method of issuing such checks or making
- 12 payments by any other means.
- 13 (b) All payments out of the several funds in the State
- 14 Treasury appropriated for public assistance shall be made by any
- 15 means acceptable to the Department of Banking and determined by
- 16 <u>the Treasury Department or</u> by check of a form prescribed and
- 17 furnished by the Treasury Department, but filled in as to name
- 18 of payee and amount by the Department of Public Assistance. As
- 19 soon after the effective date of this act as practicable but not
- 20 later than sixty (60) days after such date, the Department of
- 21 Public Assistance shall requisition the Treasury Department for
- 22 supplies of serially numbered blank checks or other materials
- 23 <u>necessary to utilize alternative methods of payment</u> upon which
- 24 to prepare disbursements for public assistance grants, and shall
- 25 give its receipt to the Treasury Department for such blank
- 26 checks and materials, provided the Department of Public
- 27 Assistance shall thereupon enter the name and address of the
- 28 payee and the amount of payment and such other information as
- 29 shall be necessary, after which it shall prepare a requisition
- 30 on the State Treasurer in the total amount of such checks, or

- 1 payment and the Treasury Department shall issue its warrant in
- 2 the total amount thereof, and shall sign and mail the checks or
- 3 <u>otherwise make payment</u> to the payees designated thereon. This
- 4 procedure shall be followed in Harrisburg and at such points
- 5 outside the City of Harrisburg as the Governor shall determine.
- 6 (c) All checks except those for payment of unemployment
- 7 compensation and public assistance shall have imprinted upon
- 8 their face a statement that they will not be honored unless
- 9 presented within six months from their date. All checks for
- 10 payment of unemployment compensation and public assistance shall
- 11 have imprinted upon their face a statement that they will not be
- 12 honored unless presented within thirty days from their date.
- 13 Alternative methods of payment utilized by the Treasury
- 14 Department shall be subject to similar limitations. Upon the
- 15 surrender of any check which would have become void because of
- 16 the failure of the holder to present if for payment within the
- 17 period for presentation imprinted upon its face, the Treasury
- 18 Department shall issue a new check to the payee or payees named
- 19 in such check in the amount thereof or validate the original
- 20 check for an additional period equal to that specified on the
- 21 original check.
- 22 The Treasury Department may, if satisfied that a check has
- 23 been lost or destroyed, and after stopping payment thereof,
- 24 issue a duplicate.
- 25 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
