AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), entitled "An 2 act relating to tax reform and State taxation by codifying 3 and enumerating certain subjects of taxation and imposing taxes thereon; providing procedures for the payment, 5 collection, administration and enforcement thereof; providing for tax credits in certain cases; conferring powers and 7 imposing duties upon the Department of Revenue, certain 8 employers, fiduciaries, individuals, persons, corporations and other entities; prescribing crimes, offenses and 9 10 penalties, " relating to sale or use tax exemption for 11 volunteer fire companies.
- 12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 13 hereby enacts as follows:
- 14 Section 1. Clause (10) of section 204, act of March 4, 1971
- 15 (P.L.6, No.2), known as the "Tax Reform Code of 1971," is
- 16 amended and the section is amended by adding a clause to read:
- 17 Section 204. Exclusions from Tax. -- The tax imposed by
- 18 section 202 shall not be imposed upon
- 19 * * *

- 1 (10) The sale at retail to or use by (i) any charitable
- 2 organization, [volunteer firemen's organization] or nonprofit
- 3 educational institution, or (ii) a religious organization for
- 4 religious purposes of tangible personal property or services:
- 5 Provided, however, That the exclusion of this clause shall not
- 6 apply with respect to any tangible personal property or services
- 7 used in any unrelated trade or business carried on by such
- 8 organization or institution or with respect to any materials,
- 9 supplies and equipment used in the construction, reconstruction,
- 10 remodeling, repairs and maintenance of any real estate, except
- 11 materials and supplies when purchased by such organizations or
- 12 institutions for routine maintenance and repairs.
- 13 * * *
- 14 (38) The sale at retail to or use by volunteer firemen's
- 15 <u>organizations of tangible property or services. However, the</u>
- 16 <u>exclusion of this clause shall not apply with respect to any</u>
- 17 tangible property or services used in any manner or for any
- 18 purpose which is not directly related to the primary purposes of
- 19 <u>such organizations</u>. This exemption shall specifically include,
- 20 but not be limited to, purchases for the construction, repair,
- 21 <u>and maintenance</u>, and the purchase of materials or services
- 22 associated therewith, made for the purpose of housing fire
- 23 fighting and rescue equipment.
- 24 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
