## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, further providing for the speed limits in school
- 3 zones.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 3362 and subsection (b)
- 7 of section 3365 of Title 75, act of November 25, 1970 (P.L.707,
- 8 No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, are
- 9 amended to read:
- 10 § 3362. Maximum speed limits.
- 11 (a) General rule. -- Except when a special hazard exists that
- 12 requires lower speed for compliance with section 3361 (relating
- 13 to driving vehicle at safe speed), the limits specified in this
- 14 subsection or established under this subchapter shall be maximum
- 15 lawful speeds and no person shall drive a vehicle at a speed in
- 16 excess of the following maximum limits:
- 17 (1) 35 miles per hour in any urban district.
- 18 (2) 55 miles per hour in other locations.

- 1 (3) 15 miles per hour in any school zone during the
- 2 <u>hours fixed by the department.</u>
- 3 [(3)] (4) Any other maximum speed limit established
- 4 under this subchapter.

- 6 § 3365. Special speed limitations.
- 7 \* \* \*
- 8 (b) School zones.--When passing a school zone as defined and
- 9 established under regulations of the department, no person shall
- 10 drive a vehicle at a speed greater than [that established for
- 11 the particular school zone] 15 miles per hour during the hours
- 12 <u>fixed by the department.</u> An official traffic-control device
- 13 shall indicate the beginning and end of each school zone to
- 14 traffic approaching in each direction. Establishment of a school
- 15 zone, including its location, hours of operation and speed
- 16 limit, shall be approved by the department.

- 18 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
