## AN ACT

Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, adding additional judges to courts of common pleas in Lycoming, Butler, Montgomery MONTGOMERY, ERIE, Lebanon, Bucks, York, Mercer, Chester, Westmoreland, MONROE, PIKE, Lehigh and Delaware AND DELAWARE counties.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 911 of Title 42, act of
November 25, 1970 (P.L.707, No.230), known as the Pennsylvania
Consolidated Statutes, amended November 26, 1978 (P.L.1264,
No.301), is amended to read:
§ 911. Courts of common pleas.
(a) General rule.--There shall be one court of common pleas for each judicial district of this Commonwealth consisting of the following number of judges:
