AN ACT

- Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the 2 3 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the 4 Executive Department thereof and the administrative departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, 6 including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or 7 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or 8 authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative 9 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative 10 officers, and of the several administrative departments, 11 12 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the 13 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of 14 15 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and 16 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the 17 18 number and compensation of the deputies and all other 19 assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and 20 commissions shall be determined, " requiring all departments, boards, commissions or other agencies of the Commonwealth to 21 22 submit bid requests and specifications to the Bureau of 23 Correction of the Department of Justice.
- 24 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 25 hereby enacts as follows:
- 26 Section 1. Section 915, act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177,
- 27 No.175), known as "The Administrative Code of 1929," is amended
- 28 by adding a clause to read:

- 1 Section 915. Inmate Labor.--The Bureau of Correction shall
- 2 have the power and its duty shall be:
- 3 * * *
- 4 (c.1) Every administrative department, board, commission or
- 5 other agency of the Commonwealth prior to purchasing goods,
- 6 furniture, supplies or equipment of any kind, shall submit to
- 7 the bureau the invitations to bid together with bid
- 8 specifications relating to the item or items intended to be
- 9 <u>purchased</u>. The intent of this clause is to give the opportunity
- 10 to the bureau to compete with other manufacturers or suppliers.
- 11 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
