- Amending the act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103, No.69), entitled "An act concerning townships of the second class; and amending, revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating
- 4 thereto, " further providing for the election of supervisors.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Subsection (A) of section 402, act of May 1, 1933
- 8 (P.L.103, No.69), known as "The Second Class Township Code,"
- 9 reenacted and amended July 10, 1947 (P.L.1481, No.567), and
- 10 amended July 13, 1961 (P.L.596, No.294), is amended to read:
- 11 Section 402. Officers to Be Elected.--(A) The electors of
- 12 each township shall elect (a) except as otherwise provided,
- 13 three supervisors, (b) one assessor, (c) three auditors, and (d)
- 14 one tax collector. One supervisor shall be a member of the party
- 15 whose candidates at the general election next preceding the
- 16 primary election at which he was nominated received next to the
- 17 <u>largest entire vote cast in the State for any elected candidate.</u>
- 18 No person shall at the same time hold more than one elective
- 19 township office: Provided, That the office of justice of the

- 1 peace shall not be considered an elective township office for
- 2 the purposes of this section.

- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
