AN ACT

- 1 Making an appropriation to The Medical College of Pennsylvania,
- 2 East Falls, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. The sum of \$2,046,000, or as much thereof as may
- 6 be necessary, is hereby specifically appropriated to The Medical
- 7 College of Pennsylvania located in East Falls, Philadelphia,
- 8 Pennsylvania, for its fiscal period July 1, 1979 to June 30,
- 9 1980 for instruction in the Doctor of Medicine program.
- 10 Section 2. The sum of \$5,000 \$250,000, or as much thereof as <—
- 11 may be necessary, is hereby appropriated TO THE MEDICAL COLLEGE <-
- 12 OF PENNSYLVANIA for the sole purpose of providing GENERAL
- 13 MAINTENANCE AND student aid for students attending the school of <-
- 14 Allied Health for the fiscal period July 1, 1979 to June 30,
- 15 1980.
- 16 Section 3. Payments to The Medical College of Pennsylvania,
- 17 located at East Falls, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, on account of
- 18 the appropriation for instruction in the Doctor of Medicine

- 1 program as provided in section 1 shall be made on the basis of
- 2 full-time student enrollment at the rate of \$4,400 per student.
- 3 Section 4. The college shall provide such information as may
- 4 be necessary to carry out the provisions of this act and in such
- 5 form and manner as the Department of Education may prescribe.
- 6 Section 5. The Medical College of Pennsylvania shall report
- 7 its revenues and expenditures and present its financial
- 8 statements in accordance with generally accepted accounting
- 9 principles and procedures for educational institutions as set
- 10 forth in the "Higher Education Finance Manual of 1975" without
- 11 exception.
- 12 Section 6. This act shall take effect July 1, 1979.
