AN ACT

- 1 Declaring and adopting the song "Pennsylvania," music and lyrics
- 2 by Gertrude Martin Rohrer, as the State song of the
- 3 Commonwealth.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. The song "Pennsylvania" music and lyrics by
- 7 Gertrude Martin Rohrer, is hereby adopted as the State song of
- 8 Pennsylvania and shall be the official song for all public
- 9 purposes. The words of the song are as follows:
- 10 Verse I
- 11 Pennsylvania, my native state,
- to you we pledge our devotion;
- Pennsylvania, our loyalty is boundless as the ocean.
- 14 Chorus
- 15 Pennsylvania, Pennsylvania, strong and true,
- 16 Pennsylvania, Pennsylvania, hear our song to you;
- 17 There is beauty in your mountains,
- 18 There is peace upon your hills,
- 19 And where'er I roam my only home is Pennsylvania.

- 2 Pennsylvania, we thrill with pride to be
- 3 your loyal descendants;
- 4 Pennsylvania, all hail to you,
- 5 the foundation of independence.
- 6 Chorus
- 7 Pennsylvania, Pennsylvania, strong and true,
- 8 Pennsylvania, Pennsylvania, hear our song to you;
- 9 There is beauty in your mountains,
- 10 There is peace upon your hills,
- 11 And where'er I roam my only home is Pennsylvania.
- 12 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
