AN ACT

1 Amending the act of December 15, 1959 (P.L.1779, No.673),
2 entitled, as amended, "An act relating to fish, frogs,
3 tadpoles and turtles; and amending, revising, consolidating
4 and changing the law relating to fish in the inland waters
5 and the boundary lakes and boundary rivers of the
6 Commonwealth," providing for a reduced license fee for
7 certain disabled persons.

8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
9 hereby enacts as follows:

10 Section 1. Section 220, act of December 15, 1959 (P.L.1779,
11 No.673), known as "The Fish Law of 1959," is amended by adding a
12 subsection to read:

13 Section 220. Resident Fishing License; Fees.--* * *

14 (b.1) Any person who was forced to retire from his regular
15 occupation due to a disability shall be entitled to receive a
16 resident fishing license pursuant to this section upon the
17 completion of the requirements of subsection (a). The fee shall
18 be in accordance with the provisions of subsection (b) relating
19 to persons who are sixty-five or more years of age.

20 * * *

21 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
