#### AN ACT

1 2 3	Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, eliminating provisions requiring color photographs on drivers' licenses and making repeals.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 1510 of Title 75, act
7	of November 25, 1970 (P.L.707, No.230), known as the
8	Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, is amended to read:
9	§ 1510. Issuance and content of driver's license.
10	(a) General ruleThe department shall, upon payment of the
11	required fee, issue to every qualified applicant a driver's
12	license indicating the type or general class of vehicles the
13	licensee is authorized to drive, which license shall contain a
14	distinguishing number identifying the licensee, the actual name,
15	date of birth, residence address, [a color photograph of the
16	licensee,] such other information as may be required by the
17	department, and either a facsimile of the signature of the
18	licensee or a space upon which the licensee shall write his
19	usual signature with pen and ink. Personal medical data and

other information for use in an emergency may be included as a part of the license. Information other than that required to identify the licensee, the distinguishing number and the class of license issued may be included in microdata form. No driver's license shall be valid until it has been signed by the licensee.

Section 2. Subsection (g) of section 2 and as much of paragraph (2) of subsection (g) of section 8, act of June 17, 1976 (P.L.162, No.81), entitled "An act amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, adding revised, compiled and codified provisions relating to vehicles and pedestrians," as relates to section 1510, are repealed. Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
