AN ACT

1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
2 Consolidated Statutes, prescribing the crime of theft of
3 gasoline and providing penalties.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Title 18, act of November 25, 1970 (P.L.707,
7 No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, is
8 amended by adding a section to read:

9 § 3933. Theft of gasoline.

10 (a) Offense defined.--A person is guilty of theft of
11 gasoline if he unlawfully takes, or exercises unlawful control
12 over gasoline or other motor fuel of another with intent to
13 deprive him thereof.

14 (b) Penalty.--Any person violating the provisions of this
15 section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor of the third degree and
16 shall be imprisoned for not less than 30 days or more than one
17 year, and shall pay a fine of not less than \$500 or more than
18 \$10,000.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
