AN ACT

1 Amending the act of July 24, 1941 (P.L.490, No.188), entitled  
2 "An act relating to acknowledgments of written instruments,  
3 and to make uniform the law with relation thereto," providing  
4 for acknowledgments by an attorney at law.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Section 7, act of July 24, 1941 (P.L.490,  
8 No.188), known as the "Uniform Acknowledgment Act," is amended  
9 by adding a clause to read:

10 Section 7. Forms of Certificates.--An officer taking the  
11 acknowledgment shall endorse thereon or attach thereto a  
12 certificate substantially in one of the following forms:
