AN ACT

1 Amending the act of July 28, 1953 (P.L.723, No.230), entitled,
2 as amended, "An act relating to counties of the second class
3 and second class A; amending, revising, consolidating and
4 changing the laws relating thereto," authorizing the jury
5 commissioners to join their State association, providing for
6 attendance at the annual meeting and authorizing payments by
7 the county pertaining thereto.

8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
9 hereby enacts as follows:

10 Section 1. Section 432, act of July 28, 1953 (P.L.723,
11 No.230), known as the "Second Class County Code," is amended by
12 adding a clause to read:

13 Section 432. State Associations Authorized.--County officers
14 of the county may join with county officers of other counties of
15 the Commonwealth and organize a State association, as follows:

16 * * *

17 (12) The jury commissioners.

18 Section 2. Section 434 and subsection (b) of section 436 of
19 the act, amended September 28, 1978 (P.L.798, No.153), are

2 Section 434. Deputies and Solicitors May Attend Annual
3 Meetings.--The deputy controller, the deputy sheriff, the deputy
4 register of wills, the deputy treasurer, the deputy
5 prothonotary, the deputy clerk of courts, the deputy recorder of
6 deeds, the deputy clerk of orphans' court, the deputy jury
7 commissioner, the first assistant district attorney, one
8 assistant public defender and the chief deputy coroner, with the
9 approval of his principal and the solicitor for each office may
10 attend the annual meetings of his respective associations,
11 either together with the controller, sheriff, register of wills,
12 prothonotary, clerk of courts, recorder of deeds, district
13 attorney, public defender, coroner, jury commissioners or
14 treasurer, as the case may be, or in his place.

15 Section 436. Other Meeting Expenses Paid by County.--* * *

16 (b) In the case of the county controllers, the sheriffs, the
17 register of wills, the county commissioners, county solicitor
18 and chief clerk, the prothonotaries and clerks of courts of
19 common pleas, the county treasurers, the recorders of deeds the
20 public defenders and the directors of veterans' affairs and the
21 jury commissioners, the portion of the annual expenses charged
22 to each county shall not exceed one hundred dollars (\$100); and
23 in the case of the probation officers, an annual membership
24 subscription not exceeding six dollars and twenty-five cents
25 (\$6.25) per member shall be paid by the county, and shall be in
26 lieu of the expenses hereinbefore in this section provided for
27 other county officers.

28 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
