## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
- 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for arrests on
- 3 boundary roads.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 42, act of November 25, 1970 (P.L.707,
- 7 No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, is
- 8 amended by adding a section to read:
- 9 § 8902. Arrests on boundary roads.
- 10 (a) General rule.--A police officer who is not otherwise
- 11 authorized to act in an adjoining political subdivision may
- 12 arrest with or without warrant any person for a summary or other
- 13 offense committed by such person on or immediately adjacent to a
- 14 boundary road of a political subdivision in which the police
- 15 officer is otherwise authorized to make similar arrests. The
- 16 arrest may be made with the same force and effect as if it were
- 17 made wholly within the territorial limits of the political
- 18 subdivision of the arresting office.

- (b) Definition. -- As used in this section: 1
- 2 "Boundary road." A public road or highway which forms the
- 3 <u>official boundary between political subdivisions.</u>
- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 4
