## AN ACT

- 1 Authorizing the Department of General Services, with the
- 2 approval of the Governor and the Department of Environmental
- Resources, to convey a parcel of land in Manheim Township,
- 4 York County, in exchange for two parcels of land located in
- West Manheim Township, York County, Pennsylvania.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Pursuant to the requirements of subsection (b) of
- 9 section 20, act of June 22, 1964 (Sp.Sess., P.L.131, No.8),
- 10 known as the "Project 70 Land Acquisition and Borrowing Act,"
- 11 the General Assembly authorizes the Department of General
- 12 Services, with the approval of the Department of Environmental
- 13 Resources and the Governor to convey to Charles W. Grubb and
- 14 Evelyn M. Grubb, husband and wife, Parcel Number 1, hereafter
- 15 described, located in Manheim Township, York County,
- 16 Pennsylvania, in exchange for Parcels Nos. 2 and 3, hereafter
- 17 described, located in West Manheim Township, York County,
- 18 Pennsylvania.
- 19 The land to be conveyed by the Department of General Services

- 1 shall be free of restrictions on use and alienation prescribed
- 2 by section 20 of the "Project 70 Land Acquisition and Borrowing
- 3 Act, "upon:
- 4 (1) substitution of the Project 70 land for land at
- 5 least equal in value; and
- 6 (2) the execution and filing of a document of release
- 7 citing such exchange and release of the land transferred by
- 8 the Department of General Services from the restrictions on
- 9 use and alienation prescribed by subsection (b) of section 20
- 10 of said act.
- 11 The document of release in such cases shall, upon such
- 12 exchange, be prepared by the Attorney General and filed in the
- 13 county in which the said land is located.
- 14 The lands to be exchanged are more particularly described as
- 15 follows:
- 16 Parcel No. 1
- 17 Beginning at an iron pin corner, said corner of beginning
- 18 being north 22 degrees 02 minutes 46 seconds east 177.10 feet
- 19 from a copperweld pin corner of Codorus State Park marked F&W
- 20 No.262; said corner of beginning being a common corner of Eyler,
- 21 lands of Charles W. Grubb, lands herein described and other
- 22 lands of Codorus State Park; thence by lands of Charles W. Grubb
- 23 and lands herein described north 22 degrees 02 minutes 46
- 24 seconds east 227.59 feet to a corner being F&W No.247; thence
- 25 continuing by lands of Grubb and by lands of St. Paul's Church
- 26 north 42 degrees 16 minutes 34 seconds east 285.56 feet to a
- 27 copperweld pin corner F&W No.248; thence by lands of said St.
- 28 Paul's Church north 45 degrees 21 minutes 02 seconds west 182.65
- 29 feet to a copperweld pin corner marked F&W No.249; thence
- 30 continuing by lands last mentioned north 44 degrees 40 minutes

- 1 29 seconds east 256.54 feet to a nail in the centerline of
- 2 Legislative Route No.66120 being corner F&W No.250; thence along
- 3 the centerline of said Legislative Route No.66120 north 45
- 4 degrees 45 minutes 40 seconds west 100.00 feet to a nail in
- 5 centerline of said route; thence by lands herein described and
- 6 other lands of Codorus State Park, south 43 degrees 31 minutes
- 7 38 seconds west 903.14 feet to an iron pin corner; thence by
- 8 lands last mentioned south 67 degrees 57 minutes 14 seconds east
- 9 394.44 feet to iron pin corner place of beginning. Containing
- 10 4.62 acres of land.
- 11 Reserving to the grantor such easements in the aforesaid
- 12 Parcel No. 1 as the grantor determines to be necessary for
- 13 planting and maintaining trees and other growth for screening
- 14 purposes and for ingress, egress and regress for the purpose of
- 15 planting and maintaining the screening areas and the State Park
- 16 boundary lines. In addition to the reservation of easements,
- 17 grantor may impose such restrictions on the use of said Parcel
- 18 No. 1 as grantor determines are reasonably necessary to preserve
- 19 the aesthetic quality of the area in the vicinity of said Parcel
- 20 No. 1.
- 21 Being part of those same two tracts of land designated as
- 22 acquisition Numbers 7 and 13 of a declaration of taking from P.
- 23 H. Glatfelter Company by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania dated
- 24 February 14, 1966 and filed to No.179 May Term 1966 in the Court
- 25 of Common Pleas of York County, Pennsylvania.
- 26 Parcel No. 2
- 27 Beginning at a copperweld pin corner marked No.98 of the
- 28 boundary of Codorus State Park being a common corner on line of
- 29 lands now or formerly of William E. Bittinger; thence by line
- 30 common to lands of Codorus State Park and lands herein described

- 1 the following five courses:
- 2 (1) North 46 degrees 04 minutes 47 seconds west 429.00
- feet to a copperweld pin marked corner No.97;
- 4 (2) North 38 degrees 57 minutes 25 seconds east 223.48
- 5 feet to a copperweld pin marked corner No.96;
- 6 (3) North 31 degrees 32 minutes 35 seconds west 419.92
- feet to a copperweld pin marked corner No.95;
- 8 (4) North 41 degrees 07 minutes 25 seconds east 362.22
- 9 feet to a copperweld pin marked corner No.95A;
- 10 (5) South 30 degrees 32 minutes 09 seconds east 867.84
- 11 feet to a copperweld pin in stones corner marked corner
- No.98A of Codorus State Park and being common to lands now or
- formerly of William E. Bittinger; thence by lands of William
- 14 E. Bittinger and lands herein described south 39 degrees 22
- minutes 13 seconds west 458.72 feet to copperweld pin corner
- place of beginning, containing 8.37 acres.
- 17 And, being all those two certain tracts of land conveyed to
- 18 Charles W. Grubb and Evelyn M. Grubb, his wife, by William E.
- 19 Bittinger et. ux., et. al. by their deed dated December 8, 1978,
- 20 and recorded in the Office of Recorder of Deeds in and for York
- 21 County in Deed Book Volume , Page .
- 22 Parcel No. 3
- 23 Beginning at a copperweld corner marked No.88C on the
- 24 boundary of Codorus State Park, said corner being also common to
- 25 lands now or formerly of William E. Bittinger and lands now or
- 26 formerly of William J. Bange; thence by line of lands of Codorus
- 27 State Park and lands herein described north 48 degrees 10
- 28 minutes 13 seconds east 256.82 feet to a copperweld pin corner
- 29 No.88B being common, to lands last mentioned; thence continuing
- 30 by lands last mentioned south 66 degrees 34 minutes 47 seconds

- 1 east 325.10 feet to a copperweld pin marked corner No.88A and
- 2 common to lands of Codorus State Park, lands now or formerly of
- 3 William J. Bange and lands herein described; thence by lands of
- 4 William J. Bange and lands herein described south 85 degrees 09
- 5 minutes 13 seconds west 491.42 feet to copperweld pin, place of
- 6 beginning. Containing 0.87 acre of land.
- 7 Being all that same tract of land conveyed to Charles W.
- 8 Grubb and Evelyn M. Grubb, his wife, by William J. Bange and
- 9 Virginia C. Bange, his wife, by their deed dated January 19,
- 10 1979 and recorded in the Office of Recorder of Deeds in and for
- 11 York County in Deed Book Volume , Page .
- 12 Section 2. The Deed of Conveyance by the Commonwealth shall
- 13 be approved by the Department of Justice and shall be executed
- 14 by the Secretary of General Services in the name of the
- 15 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. The Deed of Conveyance to the
- 16 Commonwealth shall be approved by the Department of Justice.
- 17 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
