AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," further providing for authority of school officials over pupils and providing penalties for certain interference therewith.
- 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 9 hereby enacts as follows:
- 10 Section 1. Section 1317, act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30,
- 11 No.14), known as the "Public School Code of 1949," amended July
- 12 25, 1963 (P.L.315, No.169), is amended to read:
- 13 Section 1317. Authority of Teachers, Vice Principals and
- 14 Principals over Pupils. -- Every teacher, vice principal and
- 15 principal in the public schools shall have the right to exercise
- 16 the same authority as to conduct and behavior over the pupils
- 17 attending his school, during the time they are in attendance,
- 18 including the time required in going to and from their homes, as
- 19 the parents, guardians or persons in parental relation to such
- 20 pupils may exercise over them. The same school authorities

- 1 <u>during such times shall refuse to surrender physical custody of</u>
- 2 <u>children in parental custody disagreements to a parent not</u>
- 3 having custody. Any parent attempting to gain such custody
- 4 <u>during such times shall be quilty of a misdemeanor of the third</u>
- 5 <u>degree</u>. School authorities shall surrender physical custody of
- 6 <u>such children only to the parent, quardian or person in parental</u>
- 7 relationship who enrolled the children into the school district.
- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
