AN ACT

Amending the act of October 5, 1972 (Sp.Sess.No.1, P.L.2019,

No.4), entitled, as amended, "An act implementing the 3 provisions of clause (1) of subsection (a) of section 7 of Article VIII of the Constitution of the Commonwealth of 5 Pennsylvania authorizing the incurring of debt for the rehabilitation of areas affected by the Great Storm and Floods of September, 1971 and June, 1972, and the Great Flood 7 8 of July, 1977 through urban redevelopment assistance; 9 imposing duties upon the Governor, the Auditor General and State Treasurer; prescribing the procedures for the issuance, 10 sale and payment of general obligations bonds, the funding of 11 debt and refunding of bonds; exempting said bonds from State 12 13 and local taxation; creating certain funds; and making an 14 appropriation, "further providing for the disposition of certain funds. 15 16 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 17 hereby enacts as follows: 18 Section 1. Clause (1) of subsection (d) of section 3, act of 19 October 5, 1972 (Sp.Sess.No.1, P.L.2019, No.4), entitled, as 20 amended, "An act implementing the provisions of clause (1) of 21 subsection (a) of section 7 of Article VIII of the Constitution 22 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania authorizing the incurring of debt for the rehabilitation of areas affected by the Great Storm 23 24 and Floods of September, 1971 and June, 1972, and the Great

- 1 Flood of July, 1977 through urban redevelopment assistance;
- 2 imposing duties upon the Governor, the Auditor General and State
- 3 Treasurer; prescribing the procedures for the issuance, sale and
- 4 payment of general obligations bonds, the funding of debt and
- 5 refunding of bonds; exempting said bonds from State and local
- 6 taxation; creating certain funds; and making an appropriation,"
- 7 added October 4, 1978 (P.L.969, No.191), is amended to read:
- 8 Section 3. Disposition and Use of Proceeds. --* * *
- 9 (d) Subject to the total limit of fifty million dollars
- 10 (\$50,000,000), the funds authorized to be borrowed by subclause
- 11 (ii) of section 1 shall be allocated as follows:
- 12 (1) No less than thirty million dollars (\$30,000,000) of the
- 13 funds authorized to be borrowed under this act shall be used for
- 14 housing demolition, construction, rehabilitation, relocation and
- 15 services, and other purposes necessary to provide the
- 16 infrastructure related thereto. The phrase "other purposes
- 17 necessary to provide the infrastructure related thereto" shall
- 18 be defined by the Department of Community Affairs.
- 19 Notwithstanding any other provision of this act or any other
- 20 act, if the sum authorized under this clause shall be
- 21 <u>insufficient to provide for rehabilitation of all real property</u>
- 22 damaged by the Great Storm and Floods of July, 1977, then the
- 23 <u>funds available for rehabilitation shall be distributed to</u>
- 24 persons owning such real property on a pro-rata basis and in no
- 25 case shall the income of such persons be used in any way to
- 26 <u>determine eligibility for funds under this act.</u>

- 28 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
