1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11 12	Amending the act of July 20, 1974 (P.L.551, No.190), entitled "An act relating to the right to practice medicine and surgery in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; and establishing means and methods whereby the right to practice medicine and surgery and any of its branches and limited right to practice medically related acts may be obtained, and exemptions therefrom; imposing powers and duties on the State Board of Medical Education and Licensure; providing for appropriation of board fees to carry out the provisions thereof, and for the granting, revocation and suspension of licenses; providing penalties for violations; and making repeals," providing for courses on nutrition.

15	Section 1. Section 5, act of July 20, 1974 (P.L.155,
16	No.190), known as the "Medical Practice Act of 1974," is amended
17	by adding a subsection to read:
18	Section 5. Standards for Medical Training and Facilities

20	(e) All medical colleges located within the Commonwealth
21	shall require as a condition of graduation, the completion of a
22	course on nutrition.

Section 2. This act shall take effect on September 1, next
following 90 days from the date of final enactment.
