1 2 3 4	Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for highway use by school buses, emergency vehicles and vehicles making local deliveries or pickups and further providing for penalties.
5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
б	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Section 4902(a), (c) and (e) of Title 75, act of
8	November 25, 1970 (P.L.707, No.230), known as the Pennsylvania
9	Consolidated Statutes, is amended to read:
10	§ 4902. Restrictions on use of highways and bridges.
11	(a) General ruleThe department and local authorities with
12	respect to highways and bridges under their jurisdictions may
13	prohibit the operation of vehicles and may impose restrictions
14	as to the weight or size of vehicles operated upon a highway or
15	bridge whenever the highway or bridge, by reason of
16	deterioration or rain, snow or other climatic conditions, may be
17	damaged or destroyed unless the use of vehicles is prohibited or
18	the permissible weights reduced. School buses, emergency

vehicles and vehicles making local deliveries or pickups shall
be exempt from restrictions on highways but not bridges imposed
under this subsection.

5 (c) Restrictions from traffic conditions.--The department and local authorities with respect to highways and bridges under 6 their jurisdictions may prohibit the operation of vehicles and 7 8 may impose restrictions as to the weight or size of vehicles operated upon a highway or bridge by reason of hazardous traffic 9 10 conditions or other safety factors. School buses, emergency vehicles and vehicles making local deliveries or pickups shall 11 12 be exempt from restrictions imposed under this subsection. * * * 13

14 (e) Penalty.--

15 (1) Any person operating a vehicle or combination upon a 16 highway or bridge in violation of a prohibition or 17 restriction imposed under subsection (a) is guilty of a 18 summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of \$75. In addition, any person operating a 19 20 vehicle with a gross weight in excess of the posted weight shall be sentenced to pay a fine of \$75 for each 500 pounds, 21 or part thereof, in excess of 3,000 pounds over the maximum 22 23 allowable weight. 24 (2) Any person operating a vehicle or combination in 25 violation of a prohibition or restriction imposed under

- 26 <u>subsection (c) is guilty of a summary offense and shall, upon</u>
- 27 <u>conviction</u>, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than \$100
- 28 nor more than \$500.
- 29 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
