## AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An 2 act relating to the public school system, including certain 3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto, " reducing the number of days schools 6 are required to be kept open. 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 1501, act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, 9 10 No.14), known as the "Public School Code of 1949," amended 11 September 21, 1959 (P.L.925, No.373), is amended to read: 12 Section 1501. Minimum Number of Days; School Month. -- All 13 public kindergartens, elementary and secondary schools shall be kept open each school year for at least [one hundred eighty 14

15 (180)] one hundred seventy-nine (179) days of instruction for

16 pupils. No days on which the schools are closed shall be counted

17 as days taught, and no time shall be counted as a pupil session

18 for any activity to which admission is charged. Unless otherwise

19 provided by this act, the board of school directors in any

- 1 district or joint board may keep such other schools or
- 2 departments as it may establish open during such time as it may
- 3 direct.
- 4 Twenty days of actual teaching shall constitute a school
- 5 month.
- Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall 6
- be applicable to school year 1980-1981 and thereafter.
