## AN ACT

Amending the act of July 15, 1976 (P.L.1036, No.208), entitled "An act authorizing the indebtedness, with the approval of the electors, of ten million dollars for loans to volunteer 3 fire companies, volunteer ambulance services and volunteer 5 rescue squads for the purpose of establishing or modernizing facilities to house fire fighting apparatus equipment, ambulances, and rescue vehicles, and for purchasing new fire 7 fighting apparatus equipment, ambulances, and rescue 8 9 vehicles, protective and communications equipment, and any other accessory equipment necessary for the proper 10 performance of such organizations duties, further providing 11 for the definitions of "facilities" and "volunteer fire 12 13 company". 14 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 15 hereby enacts as follows: 16 Section 1. The definitions of "facilities" and "volunteer fire company" in section 3, act of July 15, 1976 (P.L.1036, 17 18 No.208), known as the "Volunteer Fire Company, Ambulance Service and Rescue Squad Assistance Act," are amended to read: 19 20 Section 3. Definitions. -- As used in this act: 21 22 "Facilities" means facilities used to house fire fighting 23 equipment, ambulances and rescue vehicles and facilities used in

- 1 the instruction and training of members of volunteer fire
- 2 companies in the prevention, control and fighting of fires, and
- 3 <u>in related fire department emergencies</u>, and shall not include
- 4 meeting halls, social rooms, or any other facilities not
- 5 directly related to fire fighting.

- 7 "Volunteer fire company" means any nonprofit chartered
- 8 corporation, association or organization located in this
- 9 Commonwealth which provides fire protection services and other
- 10 voluntary emergency services or which provides instruction and
- 11 training to members of volunteer fire companies in the
- 12 preventing, control and fighting of fire, and in related fire
- 13 <u>department emergencies</u>, within the Commonwealth. Voluntary
- 14 emergency services provided by a volunteer fire company may
- 15 include voluntary ambulance and voluntary rescue services.
- 16 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
