AN ACT

1 2 3	Legalizing the production, procurement, distribution and dispensing of dimethyl sulfoxide (DMSO) under certain circumstances.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Short title.
7	This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Therapeutic
8	Research Act."
9	Section 2. Findings.
10	The General Assembly finds that recent research has shown
11	that the use of dimethyl sulfoxide (DMSO) is effective in the
12	treatment of arthritis and other pain causing conditions related
13	to inflammation of the joints.
14	Section 3. Limited legalization.
15	It shall be lawful to produce, distribute, prescribe and
16	dispense dimethyl sulfoxide. The production and distribution
17	shall be in Pennsylvania. Prescribing its use shall be by
18	licensed medical practitioners. Dispensing of it shall be by

hospitals and pharmacies. Its distribution to hospitals and
pharmacies shall not be construed a violation of the act of
April 14, 1972 (P.L.233, No.64), known as "The Controlled
Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act."
Section 3. Research and dispensing.
Licensed medical practitioners may dispense dimethyl

7 sulfoxide (DMSO) and conduct research in its use in the 8 treatment of scleroderma, injuries of the joints, rheumatoid 9 arthritis and osteoarthritis.

10 Section 4. Repeals.

11 All acts or parts of acts inconsistent herewith are repealed.

12 Section 5. Effective date.

13 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
