In the House of Representatives, May 7, 1979

1 WHEREAS, The residents of McKean County have been unduly
2 inconvenienced by the persistent shortages of liquor and wines
3 at Pennsylvania Liquor Stores situated within that county; and

4 WHEREAS, It is the duty of the Liquor Control Board to
5 maintain an adequate stock of wines and liquors in its stores in
6 order to provide service to its customers and to protect
7 Commonwealth tax revenues; therefore be it

8 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives urges the Liquor
9 Control Board to immediately resolve the shortage problem
10 existing in McKean County; and be it further

11 RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be immediately
12 transmitted to each member of the Liquor Control Board.
