1 RESOLVED (the Senate concurring), That the General Assembly
2 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby memorialize the
3 President of the United States and Congress of the United States
4 to oppose the closing of post offices in rural areas if postal
5 service on Saturdays is eliminated; and be it further

6 RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be delivered to
7 President Jimmy Carter, to the presiding officers of each House
8 of Congress, and to the Senators and Representatives from the
9 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
