## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, further providing for studded tires and providing
- 3 penalties.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 4525 of Title 75, act of November 25,
- 7 1970 (P.L.707, No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 8 Statutes, is amended to read:
- 9 § 4525. Tire equipment and traction surfaces.
- 10 (a) General rule. -- No vehicle shall be operated on the
- 11 highway unless the vehicle is equipped with tires of a type,
- 12 size and construction approved by the department for the vehicle
- 13 and unless the tires are in a safe operating condition as
- 14 determined in accordance with regulations of the department.
- 15 (b) Vehicles not equipped with pneumatic tires.--It is
- 16 unlawful for any person to operate or move, or cause or permit
- 17 to be moved, in contact with any highway any vehicle equipped
- 18 with traction or road contact surfaces other than pneumatic
- 19 tires unless of a type, size and construction permitted by

- 1 regulations of the department and unless the movement is made
- 2 under specific conditions allowed by regulations of the
- 3 department.
- 4 (c) [Tire] <u>Ice grips and tire</u> studs.--[No vehicle having
- 5 tires containing studs shall be driven on any highway.] <u>Tires in</u>
- 6 which ice grips or tire studs of wear resisting material have
- 7 been installed which provide resiliency upon contact with the
- 8 road and which have projections not exceeding two thirty-seconds
- 9 of an inch beyond the tread of the traction surface of the tire
- 10 shall be permitted between November 1 of each year and April 1
- 11 of the following year. The Governor may by executive order
- 12 <u>extend the time tires with ice grips or tire studs may be used</u>
- 13 when highway conditions are such that such tires would be a
- 14 safety factor in traveling Commonwealth highways. Firefighting,
- 15 fire emergency and police vehicles may use tires with ice grips
- 16 or tire stude during any time of the year. The use of tires with
- 17 ice grips or tire studs contrary to the provisions of this
- 18 subsection shall be unlawful.
- 19 (d) Tire chains.--Tires chains may be temporarily used on
- 20 vehicles during periods of snow and ice emergency if they are in
- 21 conformance with regulations promulgated by the department.
- 22 (e) Penalty.--
- 23 (1) Any person violating the provisions of subsection
- 24 (c) shall be guilty of a summary offense and upon conviction
- 25 <u>thereof, shall be sentenced to pay a fine as indicated in</u>
- 26 paragraph (2) and in default of payment thereof, shall
- 27 undergo imprisonment for not more than 30 days.
- 28 (2) Fines for violation of subsection (c) shall be
- 29 determined from the following chart based on the period of
- 30 unauthorized use:

1	May 1 to May 31	<u>\$35</u>
2	June 1 to June 30	45
3	July 1 to July 31	<u>55</u>
4	August 1 to August 31	<u>55</u>
5	September 1 to September 30	<u>55</u>
6	October 1 to October 31	<u>55</u>
7	November 1 to April 30	_10
8	Section 2. This act shall take effect	immediately.
