AN ACT

1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for costs and
3 expenses involving extradition of certain persons and making
4 an appropriation.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Title 42, act of November 25, 1970 (P.L.707,
8 No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, is
9 amended by adding a section to read:

10 § 9144.1. Payment of expenses, costs and fees.

11 All costs and expenses shall be paid out of the county
12 treasury in the county wherein the crime is alleged to have been
13 committed: Provided, however, That all costs and expenses
14 incurred by a county in extraditing a person who, upon release
15 from a Federal prison, is apprehended on a writ of detainer
16 issued by a state other than Pennsylvania, shall be reimbursed
17 by the Department of Justice. Reimbursable costs and expenses
18 incurred in any extradition proceeding shall include, but not be
19 limited to, apprehending, securing, transmitting and maintaining

1 the prisoner, as well as food, court fees and counsel fees.

2 Section 2. The sum of \$10,000, or as much thereof as may be
3 necessary, is appropriated to the Department of Justice in order
4 to carry out the provisions of this act.

5 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately and shall
6 be retroactive to December 2, 1976.
