AN ACT

1 Authorizing the Department of Environmental Resources, with the
2 approval of the Governor, to transfer A RIGHT-OF-WAY IN that <—
3 portion of the Boal Gap Road passing through the Rothrock
4 State Forest situate in the Township of Potter, County of
5 Centre and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, to said Potter
6 Township.

7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8 hereby enacts as follows:

9 Section 1. The Department of Environmental Resources, with
10 the approval of the Governor, is hereby authorized on behalf of
11 the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to transfer to the Township of
12 Potter in the County of Centre A RIGHT-OF-WAY IN that portion of <—
13 road, known as Boal Gap Road, which passes through the Rothrock
14 State Forest, situate in the Township of Potter, County of
15 Centre, and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, beginning at Potter
16 Township Road T-413 and proceeding in a southerly direction to
17 the Rothrock State Forest boundary, a distance of approximately
18 3,907 feet, UPON SUCH TERMS AND CONDITIONS AS THE COMMONWEALTH <—
19 AND TOWNSHIP SHALL AGREE.

1 Section 2. All documents relating to the aforesaid transfer
2 shall be approved by the Department of Justice.
3 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
