6	Section 1. Section 6306 of Title 75, act of November 25,
7	1970 (P.L.707, No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated
8	Statutes, added April 28, 1978 (P.L.202, No.53), is amended to
9	read:
10	§ 6306. Costs for summary offenses.
11	(a) General rule[Costs] <u>Except as provided in subsection</u>
12	(c), costs for summary offenses shall be established by general
13	rule pursuant to Chapter 17 of Title 42 (relating to governance
14	of the system).
15	(b) Costs of removing vehicle(Reserved).
16	(c) Parking violations in first class citiesThe costs
17	normally imposed for a summary parking violation of this title
18	or of a parking ordinance shall be waived in the following

1 <u>situations:</u>

2	(1) When the defendant has been issued a parking ticket
3	and he remits the fine within eight days of the parking
4	<u>ticket's issuance.</u>
5	(2) When the defendant, who has not been previously
6	issued a parking ticket for the alleged parking violation,
7	has been issued a citation and he remits the fine within
8	eight days of the citation's issuance.
9	If the fine is remitted by mail, then a remittance postmarked
10	within the eight-day period shall be considered as meeting the
11	requirements of this subsection. The provisions of this
12	subsection shall only be applicable to summary parking
13	violations occurring in cities of the first class.
14	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
