AN ACT

Amending the act of June 23, 1931 (P.L.932, No.317), entitled "An act relating to cities of the third class; and amending, revising, and consolidating the law relating thereto," authorizing taxation for the purpose of paying interest and principal on certain indebtedness.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Clause 2. of section 2531, act of June 23, 1931 (P.L.932, No.317), known as "The Third Class City Code," reenacted and amended June 28, 1951 (P.L.662, No.164) and amended November 19, 1959 (P.L.1519, No.534), is amended to read:

Section 2531. Tax Levies.--Council may, by ordinance, levy and provide for the collection of the following taxes:
