AN ACT

- 1 Authorizing the Secretary of Environmental Resources to
- 2 establish a Volunteers in State Parks and Forests Program and
- 3 for other purposes.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. The Secretary of Environmental Resources,
- 7 hereinafter referred to as the secretary, is authorized to
- 8 recruit, train and accept without regard to the civil service
- 9 classification laws, rules or regulations, the services of
- 10 individuals without compensation as volunteers for or in aid of
- 11 interpretive functions, visitor services, conservation measures
- 12 and development or other activities in and related to State park
- 13 and forest areas administered by the secretary through the
- 14 Bureau of State Parks and Bureau of Forestry.
- 15 Section 2. The secretary is authorized to provide for
- 16 incidental expenses, such as transportation, uniforms, lodging
- 17 and subsistence.
- 18 Section 3. (a) Except as otherwise provided in this

- 1 section, a volunteer shall not be deemed to be a Commonwealth
- 2 employee and shall not be subject to the provisions of law
- 3 relating to Commonwealth employment, including those relating to
- 4 hours of work, rates of compensation, leave, unemployment
- 5 compensation and Commonwealth employee benefits.
- 6 (b) Volunteers performing work under the terms of this act
- 7 shall be authorized to operate Commonwealth vehicles and shall
- 8 be treated for the purposes of automotive and general liability
- 9 as employees of the Commonwealth.
- 10 (c) For the purposes of the act of June 2, 1915 (P.L.736,
- 11 No.338), known as "The Pennsylvania Workmen's Compensation Act,"
- 12 as amended, relating to compensation to employees for work
- 13 injuries, volunteers under the provisions of this act shall be
- 14 deemed employees of the Commonwealth within the meaning of the
- 15 term "employe" as defined in section 104 of said act and the
- 16 provisions of that law shall apply.
- 17 Section 4. The Department of Environmental Resources shall
- 18 have the power and authority to do all things necessary and
- 19 expedient to establish and operate a Volunteers in State Parks
- 20 and Forests Program and to promulgate rules and regulations
- 21 under this act.
- 22 Section 5. This act shall take effect immediately.
