AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, defining the offense of injury to or
- 3 interference with police dogs and horses and providing
- 4 penalties.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Title 18, act of November 25, 1970 (P.L.707,
- 8 No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, is
- 9 amended by adding a section to read:
- 10 § 5511.1. Injury to or interference with police dogs or
- 11 horses.
- 12 A person is quilty of a misdemeanor of the third degree if he
- 13 tortures, torments, beats, kicks, kills, strikes, mutilates,
- 14 injures, disables or otherwise mistreats, a dog or horse owned
- 15 by a police department or police agency of the Commonwealth or
- 16 any of its political subdivisions, or who otherwise interferes
- 17 with the lawful performance of such dog or horse.
- 18 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
